





## NEED HELP PAYING FOR CHILD CARE?

YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR ASSISTANCE!



## **ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES**

Onondaga County's child care assistance program covers most (and sometimes all) of the cost of care. Families may qualify if they:

- Are working and they meet income eligibility guidelines (see chart at right)
- Are attending high school, a high school equivalency program (GED), a two- or four-year college degree program, or a training program
- Have an active Temporary Assistance case; are homeless; are receiving services for victims of domestic violence; have an open protective or preventative services case; are participating in a substance abuse treatment program; are enrolled in vocational, ESL, remedial, or literacy training; or are experiencing a short-term medical emergency
